

LEAVITT TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING  
HELD AT TOWNSHIP HALL  
APRIL 11, 2016  
7:00 P.M.

SUPERVISOR, JOHN HERREMANS, CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M. THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WAS RECITED. ROLL CALL TAKEN – ALL BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT. ASSESSOR, DAN KIRWIN, WAS ABSENT. GUESTS WERE JIM & BARB YANCEY, NAOMI OOMEN, MARIA TRIVISONNO, LARRY MUMPER, CARRIE, MORGAN, LUKE & DUKE KRUPPE. MOTION WAS MADE BY PURDY AND SUPPORTED BY E. KRUPPE TO ACCEPT THE SPECIAL MEETING, BUDGET HEARING, ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING AND REGULAR MARCH MEETING MINUTES. CARRIED. THE TREASURER’S REPORT FOR APRIL WAS GIVEN.

OLD BUSINESS: THE SUPERVISOR WILL ASK THE ROAD COMMISSION TO GRADE THE PARKING LOT AT THE TOWNSHIP HALL. THE DAMAGE CAUSED TO THE TOWNSHIP PROPERTY BY THE HESPERIA SCHOOL BUS STILL NEEDS TO BE COMPLETED WHEN THE GROUND DRIES OUT FURTHER.

LARRY MUMPER CAME TO THE MEETING TO DISCUSS THE BRINING OF VAN BUREN ROAD. MOTION WAS MADE BY PURDY AND SUPPORTED BY D. KRUPPE TO HAVE COLFAX TWP. BRINE ALL OF VAN BUREN RD. FOR THE SAME PRICE AS LAST YEAR - \$853.13 – AND TO HAVE COLFAX TWP. BRINE IT ANNUALLY SUBJECT TO YEARLY RENEWAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIPS. CARRIED.

NEW BUSINESS: THE CLERK WILL CONTACT JONS-TO-GO AND HAVE THE PORTA-JON INSTALLED AT CAMPBELL LAKE.

THE TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP DAY WAS DISCUSSED AND SCHEDULED FOR MAY 21<sup>ST</sup>. THE CLERK WILL CONTACT THE DUMPSTER COMPANY AND ADVERTISE THE CLEAN-UP DAY IN THE HI-LITES.

THE CEMETERY AND PARK BIDS FOR MAINTENANCE WERE OPENED. THE PARK BID WAS DISCUSSED FIRST. THE POINT WAS MADE THAT SOME BIDS DID NOT INCLUDE WEEKLY GARBAGE REMOVAL. THE CLERK STATED THAT THE BIDS HAD NEVER PREVIOUSLY SPECIFIED THAT THERE WAS TO BE WEEKLY GARBAGE REMOVAL. IT WILL BE INCLUDED IN NEXT YEAR’S BIDDING PROCESS. MOTION WAS MADE BY HERREMANS AND SUPPORTED BY D. KRUPPE TO AWARD THE PARK BID TO AL’S SNOWPLOWING. ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN: E. KRUPPE-YES, PURDY-ABSTAIN, HERREMANS-YES, D. KRUPPE-YES, KOLBE-NO. MOTION PASSED – 3 YES, 1 NO, 1 ABSTENTION. THE CEMETERY BIDS WERE DISCUSSED NEXT. THE CLERK STATED HE THOUGHT THERE WAS ENOUGH DIFFERENCE IN THE BIDS THAT THE BOARD SHOULD TAKE THE LOWEST BID. MOTION WAS MADE BY HERREMANS AND SUPPORTED BY D. KRUPPE TO AWARD THE CEMETERY BID TO AL’S SNOWPLOWING. ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN: E. KRUPPE-YES, PURDY-

ABSTAIN, HERREMANS-YES, D. KRUPPE-YES, KOLBE-NO. MOTION PASSED – 3 YES, 1 NO, 1 ABSTENTION.

THE TREASURER STATED THAT HE HAD NOT YET VISITED LAKE-OSCEOLA BANK BUT WILL DO SO.

MOTION WAS MADE BY D. KRUPPE AND SUPPORTED BY PURDY TO PAY THE CURRENT BILLS. CARRIED. MOTION WAS MADE BY PURDY AND SUPPORTED BY E. KRUPPE TO ADJOURN. CARRIED.
