GUESTS WERE JIM YANCEY, MORGAN KRUPPE, MARIA TRIVISONNO AND DEANNA HELMLINGER. NORM BAKER ARRIVED AFTER THE MEETING HAD STARTED. MOTION WAS MADE BY PURDY AND SUPPORTED BY E. KRUPPE TO ACCEPT THE APRIL MINUTES. CARRIED. THE TREASURER'S REPORT FOR MAY WAS GIVEN.
