SUPERVISOR, JOHN HERREMANS, CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M. THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WAS RECITED. ROLL CALL TAKEN – ALL BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT. ASSESSOR, DAN KIRWIN, WAS ABSENT. GUESTS WERE MARIA TRIVISONNO, MORGAN KRUPPE, DEANNA HELMLINGER, TIM PRIESE, JERRY KROLL, GAIL SCHULTE AND ROY STRAIT. MOTION WAS MADE BY PURDY AND SUPPORTED BY E. KRUPPE TO ACCEPT THE JUNE MINUTES. CARRIED. THE TREASURER’S REPORT FOR JULY WAS GIVEN.

OLD BUSINESS: AL PURDY REPORTED HE HAD TRIMMED THE DEAD TREE AT GOODRICH CEMETERY AND WILL CUT IT DOWN SOON.

THE TOWNSHIP ROADS WERE BRINED THE FIRST FULL WEEK OF JULY.

NEW BUSINESS: TIM PRIESE AND ROY STRAIT, BOTH CANDIDATES FOR OCEANA COUNTY SHERIFF, EACH TALKED SHORTLY ABOUT THEIR CAMPAIGNS. GAIL SCHULTE, WHO IS RUNNING FOR OCEANA COUNTY TREASURER, ALSO TALKED BRIEFLY. JERRY KROLL, DISCUSSED HIS RUN FOR OCEANA COUNTY DRAIN COMMISSIONER.

DEANNA HELMLINGER ATTENDED THE MEETING TO TALK ABOUT WALKERVILLE THRIVES AND STATED THERE WOULD BE A “MEET THE CANDIDATES” NIGHT ON JULY 21ST AT 6:00 P.M. AT THE WALKERVILLE WESLEYAN CHURCH.

AL PURDY SAID RICHARD GORENFLO HAD CONTACTED HIM AND WANTED TO SEE ABOUT GETTING THE BRUSH CLEANED OUT BY THE EAST DRIVE AT CARPENTER CEMETERY. AFTER SHORT DISCUSSION, MOTION WAS MADE BY D. KRUPPE AND SUPPORTED BY E. KRUPPE TO HIRE AL PURDY AT \$50.00 PER HOUR TO BRING HIS TRACTOR TO THE CEMETERY AND PULL THE BRUSH OUT. CARRIED. THE FOLLOWING ELECTION INSPECTORS WERE APPOINTED FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON AUG. 2, 2016: REPUBLICAN PARTY-ALBERTA WARMUSKERKEN AND CAROL CREED, DEMOCRATIC PARTY-RUBY DERKS AND CONNIE TONEY. ALBERTA WARMSKERKEN AND RUBY DERKS WILL SERVE AS THE RECEIVING BOARD.

AL PURDY ALSO STATED THE TOWNSHIP NEEDED SOME SAND AT THE CAMPBELL LAKE PARK. FREE SAND IS AVAILABLE AT THE SILVER LAKE SAND DUNES TURNAROUND. HE STATED A TRUCK OR TRAILER WOULD BE NEEDED TO HAUL THE SAND.
